Key Speakers were Dr. Enrico Libera, EU Project Coordinator, and Dr. Roshan Babaee Hemmati, Chairman of the Iran Creative Tourism Center. Read More

On 10th December 2020, a webinar was held by Marefat Pardis Toos (MPT) on the Topic "Post COVID-19 Tourism Trends: Planning and Way Forward". Key Speakers included Dr. Vrinda Dar, NECOS President, and Dr.Shervan Shoaee, Non-Communicable Diseases Research Center (NCDRC). The experts shared that tourism was one of the hardest hit economic sectors by COVID-19, international





tourist arrivals in 2020 having decreased between 58% - 78%. 100 to 120 with 50% tourism related jobs still at risk. They shared that UNWTO in its 112 Executive Council Sept 2020 Session recommended that tourism be a priority sector for incentives and recovery support by government and investment agencies and that markets and products be diversified, They shared how the world was re-thinking tourism and that the emerging trends include among others: slow and responsible tourism, closer engagement and contact with local communities, going back to nature, combining work with travel especially for those working largely from home, smaller groups rather than mass tourism, staying longer periods in one destination rather than short travels with rapidly changing destinations, health retreats, preferring quality over quantity, etc.


