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SITES TO VISIT

“SIRAF”

Siraf is an ancient port town in southern Iran, also known for its burial places overlooking the hills. The tomb of Qutb al-Din Sirafi, an Iranian scholar in Shi'ite Islam, and Gur-e Sibuyeh are symbols of the ancient city of Siraf. Archaeologists say that structures placed along the hill slopes were used for rainwater harvesting and the water overflow on the higher level reservoirs were collected in ponds downhill.

“ASALUYEH”

The Nayband Marine National Park, in the southern Iranian province of Bushehr, spreads across an area of 42 thousand hectares. With rare plant and animal species and unique

coral reef, mangrove forest, sandy beaches, rocky shores, seaweeds, numerous coves and old fig trees, this park is one of the precious marine habitats and ecosystem in the Persian Gulf,

“BORAZJAN FORTRESS”

Moshir-ol-Molk Caravanserai is a Qajar building and it has endured many years because of its strong structure. Moshir-ol-Molk Caravanserai is in the form of a rectangular. It has four towers and is more than twelve meters high. The materials used in this building are mostly stones and Sarooj, a type of water-resistant mortar, which makes it stronger in comparison with other buildings of its kind. The building is two-story on its other parts, and each story has two alcoves. This has turned Borazjan into a lively city with a long history and monuments such as Bardak Sia

“PALM GROVES”

Palm Groves is like a jewel on the ring of Bushehr province. Dashtestan city and Abpakhsh have the largest number of palms in this region. The lush and tall groves at the entrance to the city of Abpakhsh have created a very spectacular landscape in this area and travelers often do not pass without stopping.

“Dalaki Caravanserai”

The structure belongs to the late Qajar period. The common form of architecture of the time can be observed in this caravanserai: a central yard with rooms around and barns in the back side of rooms. In the outer corners, there are four towers that are connected to the inner part of caravanserai by a small doorway. What is interesting about this caravanserai is that it is built up of river stones.

“BUSHEHR”

The Dehdashti Edifice of Bushehr is a beautiful old home in Bushehr belonging to a rich oil merchant - Haj Gholam Hossein Dehdashti. The old part of the Bushehr city hosts many spectacular homes and mansions, some of which have been reconstructed or converted into a museum.

“Cafe Naaji” is not just a cafe but an integral and important part of Bushehr's culture. The Naji family has played a crucial role in keeping alive music and cultural traditions.

In the traditional old Bazaar of Bushehr, we can experience the local culture and traditional economic activities. Located in Dehdashti neighbourhood, the bazaar dates back 200 years

5 DAYS TOUR

Day 1.

Arrival in Assaloyeh and travel to Siraf by Car. Visit to historical places in Siraf, like the ancient Siraf graveyard, ancient monuments on the port, and stay at the Ahid Traditional House in Kangan

Day 2.

Paddle boating at the Nayband national park, bicycle ride to watch the sunset, Bird watching

Day 3.

Travel to Bushehr City and Dinner at an old and popular restaurant (Amo Hossein Restaurant), stay at Man Hamishe Sabz Residency, walking tour of the historical part of the city - Saadat School, Dehdashti Edifice and lunch at Amo Hossein fish restaurant

Day 4.

Stay at Demit Home Stay, nature-based activities - climbing up the Date tree into Abpakhsh city and visiting the palm grove

Day 5.

Visit to the Old Bazaar of Bushehr for shopping and experiencing the local culture, listening to traditional music, dinner at Chavam Restaurant, departure to Tehran
